RE: Remington Custom 375 H&H Magnum

Dear Bud and Ted:

Per our phone conversation of September 27, 1990 I would like to review with you the facts and events surrounding my recent trip to Tanzania, Africa.

First, my wife purchased from your store in December of 1989 a new Remington Custom 375 H&H Magnum. It was given to me as a somewhat expected X-mas present!

In the early days of May 1990 I started shooting the rifle a couple times a month. Two of these times were with both of you. I shot from a bench in single shot fashion and experienced no problem with the gun.

In late July I left with both of you plus Russell Underdahl on a 21 day trip to hunt in Western and Northern Tanzania. After arriving in the Western camp with Russ Underdahl as the other hunter in camp I started my safari hunting with a PH from Weingert Safari Ltd. by the name of Jeff Weinright. Jeff has been a PH for 20 years and is widely respected and known in Zambia and Tanzania.

On the first day of the hunt I noticed difficulty in loading the magazine of my gun. After killing a Zebra the second shell failed to move into the chamber. Because the first shot was a killing shot it did not effect the first day hunt but that evening and the next morning we took the gun apart to see if the magazine was defective. Because I had a video camera with I took movies of the corrective work we tried to do. We put the gun back together realizing I had basically
