Dear Yr. Edwards:

Examination has been completed on your Model 700, 25/06 caliber rifle, serial number 6524577, which allesedly fired when the safety was pushed to the fire position.

Cur experts thoroughly examined the rifle, and triceer assembly and could not duplicate the incident you have described. All parts, tolerances and dimensions were found to be normal, including some commencer encapement. Also, factory scals were intent on the triceer adjustment screws, indicating no alternations were made to the triangle outside of the Company.

Based on our findings, Reminston Arms Co., Inc., cannot accept any liability or responsibility for this incident. We can only assume that as the safety was rushed to the "fire" position, contact was made with the printer. Then the safety is in the "on safe" position, the sear is lifted off of the trigger connector and vary little effort is required to pull the trigger reasonated unknowingly, thus taking the trigger out from under the sear. If the trigger is held in the reasonated position while the safety layer is moved to the "fire" position, the sear having no trigger to rest on drops away from the notch in the striker as soon as the disconnector is moved away by the safety layer, thus causing the striker to move forward and the gun to fire.

This happens so fast that the shooter does not realize that he has pulled the trigger and he attributes the "accidental" firing to gun maximum.

We trust that we have clarified the circumstances that could possibly has caused the accidental firing. The firearm will be returned as received, or if you so desire and as a gesture of goodwill, even though there is nothing wrong with your present trigger, assembly, we can replace it with another assembly at no charge.
