Thank you for your recent letter and your concerns regarding trigger adjustment and our Model 700 bolt lock gun.

Sometime ago, we did remove the bolt lock feature on the Model 700 for reasons associated with those outlined in your letter. However, for those customers desiring the bolt lock feature, we will service the rifle accordingly for a minimum charge. We do realize that the original bolt lock design is a preferable one to many hunters as it negates brush, branches, etc. from lifting the bolt handle thus putting the rifle in a non-firing condition. Therefore, we still carry the bolt lock as an option.

We do appreciate your concern, Mr. Smith, and thank you for it. It's because of recommendations from responsible sportsmen like yourself that Remington keeps abreast of shooter needs and concerns.
