I purchased a 7mm Remington Magnum Bolt Action Rifle on 11-6-821 The model **sumber is 700, grade ADL with a 24 inch barrel!length, order #5776.

I have fired this rifle no more than a dozen times, and have kept the rifle cleaned at all times.

Last year on the first day of deer season, I loaded two rounds into the chamber. I saw no deer that day, so I attempted to unload the two rounds at which time complications occurred. I pulled the bolt back to kick the round out and the gun fired, causing considerable damage to my pickup. I then closed the chamber and repeated all of the same actions. Once again the gun fired. I examined the chamber and noticed fragments of brass throughout the chamber.
