IT TO ME AS A GIFT, AND THE GUN INITIATED ME  
INTO WHAT IS NOW MY FAVORITE HOBBY: HUNTING.  
I ALSO PURCHASED AND OWN AN 1100, 12 GA. WHICH I USE  
OFTEN.

ON DEC. 31, 1989 (I REMEMBER THE DAY EXACTLY) <sup>AND I</sup>  
THE BEST MAN IN MY WEDDING, ALBIERMAN <sup>AND I</sup> WERE  
DEER HUNTING IN TEXAS. AS WE WERE WALKING IN  
FROM HUNTING IT STARTED TO RAIN, SO WE BROUGHT
