I am sending my Remington model 788 to you because it has a safety problem. On several occasions, when you take the gun off safety, it was very hard to pull the trigger and make it fire. On Thanksgiving day, before the Pennsylvania buck season I took the gun to the range to site it in. The first shot fired, but the trigger was very hard to pull. I tried it again with a second shot and I put the gun on safe, aligned the sites placed the safety on fire and the gun would not go off. I then stood up at the bench opened the bolt and removed the round put the round back in the chamber and I was closing the bolt when the gun went off! I have a son who is relatively new to hunting and with this defect it is dangerous for him or anyone to use!! If at all possible could you please fix this problem or do something for me? Also one of the biggest problems with this type of safety on this gun is that you have to be on fire to operate the bolt, for loading or unloading.
