Problem: GUN Discharges ON its OWN (SAFETY OF TRIGGER) &

I am returning my 30-06 Model 700/BDL to be thoroughly checked out by our repair department.

During a recent hunting trip I experienced a frightening discovery about this gun. The morning of the hunt I was loading the rifle as usual with the lafety on and gun pointing in a safe direction. After chambering the last round I engaged the bolt and took the safety off. It was at this time that the gun discharged on its own. Being extremely startled by this, I immediately unloaded the gun and brought it back to camp.

Unfortunately I have been able to duplicate this trouble a number of different times and ways. As mentioned above, with the safety on and bolt engaged, taking the safety off will cause a discharge. Also on occasion with the safety off, simply engaging the bolt will cause the same, a discharge. As a long time owner of Remington Firearms this is the first incident that I can recall where there has been any defect in craftsmanship.

Please notify me of the findings and actions that that will be taken to rectify this problem.
