On your report # 95-29675 the damage was caused by Hi-pressure from the shell. As you will see I only use Remington shells and I have never used reloads in the 270,

What bothers me is that Remington is suppose to be one of the best guns sold and that they will last you a lifetime. As you could see the rifle I returned was not abused or mistreated.

I feel that Remington should back the rifle 100%, since one of the Remington products were at fault.
