The bullet stuck him in the chest causing several broken ribs and a collapsed lung. He was hospitalized for 30 days and had several months of therapy following that. I sent ARS label, e-mail and letter - overnighted on 12/1/2003. Contacted him 4:30 PM via phone - He said he is doing good, has full range of motion - was sighting gun in, in a hurry to get back to camp he didn't unload it, and then forgot it was loaded. Next day he went to clean it, bolt stuck he turned gun to see what was going on and while he was moving bolt the rifle fired. He said he did not know if he had his thumb in the trigger guard - that it was possible. He also said that the safety was off.
