Dear Mr. & Mrs. Thrasher,

We were sorry to learn of the unfortunate incident that you experienced. We are certainly glad that the results were limited to property damage and that no one was injured. As we understand it, you experienced an accidental discharge with your bolt lock style Model 700 rifle. We have agreed to wave the normal \$20 charge to remove the bolt lock style trigger assembly. We will examine the rifle prior to making any repairs to try to determine the cause of the incident that you experienced.

We have also asked that you provide us with photographs of the damage and a repair estimate for our records. I have enclosed an ARS label and shipping box for you to return the rifle to my attention. Please include a copy of this letter inside the shipping box. The letter inside the box is important as sometimes the outside label gets damaged and we want to be sure the rifle is logged in correctly.
