

The stainless steel barreled action features Remington's innovative TriNyte™ Corrosion Control System, a proprietary multi-step process, utilizing a Physical Vapor Deposition (PVD) coating of zirconium nitride. This extremely hard, but micro-thin coating provides superior scratch resistance and corrosion resistance. Traditional stainless steel barrels contain an element of carbon, so when exposed to the elements these barrels can rust, not the XCR. Combine this corrosion resistance with a harder-than-nails surface and you have the ultimate rifle for any hunting condition. Fitting this weather-impervious barreled action into a top-of-the-line synthetic stock adds to the toughness of this Model 700. Designed with a rubber overmolding technology from Hogue, this durable stock has easy-gripping, overmolded panels in the grip and fore-end areas. Other features include nickel plated fire control components for added corrosion resistance, clean 24-inch barrel on short magnum and long action calibers and a 26-inch barrel on magnums, drilled and tapped for scope mounts, hinged floorplate, sling swivel studs and the amazing, recoil-reducing R3™ Recoil Pad.

REMINGTON INTRODUCES A COMPETITIVE-GRADE SINGLE SHOT TARGET RIFLE - THE MODEL XR-100™ RANGEMASTER*

Madison, NC – For the first time in its nearly 200 year history, Remington is pleased to announce a custom-grade, single shot target rifle direct from the factory – the **Model XR-100 Rangemaster** available in .204 Ruger, .223 Rem and .22-250 Rem. This competition-ready single shot, based on the legendary Remington XP-100™ pistol action, is designed for precision accuracy at half the cost of traditional custom target rifles.

The **Model XR-100 Rangemaster** has many unique features that set this rifle apart from the competition. A first for a Remington production gun, this target rifle has an externally adjustable Model 40-X™ target trigger, allowing trigger pull weight to be adjusted from 1½ to 3½ pounds. The solid bottom receiver design offers one of the most rigid and stable actions available, delivering pinpoint accuracy. Further precision-enhancing features include lightening vent cuts in the fore-end under the barrel channel for improved heat dissipation and a heavy barreled, varmint contour 26-inch barrel with concave target crown. The action is fit to a competition-style thumbhole stock with beavertail fore-end, which provides the stability needed when every shot counts. Complimenting the gray laminate stock with rollover cheekpiece is the satin blued finish on the barrel and receiver.

The name Remington is synonymous with "out-of-the-box" accuracy and reliability and this "tack driving" single shot rifle is built on that same legendary reputation. The **Model XR-100 Rangemaster** is available at a suggested retail price of \$879.

UPGRADED FEATURES ADDED TO PROVEN REMINGTON® MODEL 700™ VS™ (VARMINT SYNTHETIC) LINE

Madison, NC – Remington has provided varmint hunters and precision benchrest shooters with a line of extremely accurate, heavy barreled production rifles with its Model 700 offerings since the Varmint Special introduction in the late '60s. In response to our customers' requests, the Model 700 VS family has been upgraded with new features for 2005, while maintaining all the legendary performance features of the Model 700 platform. The new **Model 700 VSF™ (Varmint Synthetic Fluted)** is offered in .22-250 Rem, .223 Rem and .308 Win with right and left-handed versions available and the **Model 700 VS SF™ II (Varmint Synthetic Stainless Fluted)** is offered in .204 Ruger, .223 Rem, .220 Swift and .22-250 Rem.

Both redesigned Varmint Synthetic rifles feature the rigid cylinder-designed Model 700 action milled from a solid bar of steel, providing "right out of the box" accuracy and consistency from shot to shot. The renowned Remington "three-rings-of-steel" design (counterbored bolt face encloses the cartridge head with an unbroken ring of steel, which then fits inside of the barrel chamber, surrounded by the receiver) provides, perhaps, for the most strength and most reliable performance from any production gun. Crisp trigger, exceptionally fast lock time and hammer-forged barrels further enhance the Model 700 rifle's accuracy. Unique to our Varmint Synthetic line of rifles is full length aluminum bedding for consistent shot placement.

The upgrade of the Model 700 VS rifles begins with a reconfigured H.S. Precision composite stock. Features of this well-designed, varmint stock include a contoured beavertail fore-end with defined ambidextrous finger grooves, palm swell and twin front tactical-style swivel studs to accommodate a sling and bipod. A textured, black webbed finish completes the new package. Desert tan finished stocks will be featured on the **Model 700 VSF** and a Tactical green finish on the **Model 700 VS SF II** stock.

Heavy contour, 26-inch hammer-forged barrels with concave target-style crown deliver long-range accuracy and the addition of six longitudinal flutes provides rigidity and increased heat dissipation as well as weight reduction on both models. Adding to the appeal of the **Model 700 VS SF II** is the powder-coated finish on the flutes and spin polished finish on exposed metalwork. The **Model 700 VSF** has a carbon steel barrel with traditional satin blued finish and the barrel on the **Model 700 VS SF II** is constructed of 416 stainless steel.

The **Model 700 VSF** and **Model 700 VS SF II** answer the needs of dedicated varmint hunters and long-range precision shooters. Both redesigned Model 700 VS rifles will be available during the fourth quarter of 2004 at suggested retail prices of \$932 to \$1025.

LEFT-HANDED VERSIONS AND NEW CALIBER OFFERINGS ADDED TO THE MODEL 700™ CDL™ (CLASSIC DELUXE) LINE

Madison, NC – Introduced in 2004, the Remington® Model 700 CDL answered the demands of traditional hunter and shooters with its classic styling and rugged durability. For 2005, Remington is pleased to introduce a Left-Handed Model 700 CDL bolt-action in six popular caliber choices and two new caliber offerings in the right-handed Model 700 CDL version.

This well-designed Model 700 is housed in a straight comb, satin finished American walnut stock with black fore-end tip and grip cap. Fit with the R3™ Recoil Pad, the Model 700 CDL comfortably handles the recoil of even the high-powered magnums. The standard calibers feature a clean 24-inch, carbon steel barrel (26-inch on magnum calibers) with satin blued finish. A jeweled bolt body completes the look. The hinged floor-plate magazine has a four round capacity in the standard calibers and three round in the magnum calibers. Like all Model 700 rifles, the CDL combines impress lock time, solid construction and advanced design, resulting in great accuracy "right-out-of-the-box".

The Left-Handed Model 700 CDL is available in .223 Rem, .243 Win, .270 Win, .30-06 Sprg, 7mm Rem Mag and .300 Remington Ultra Mag. Suggested retail prices range from \$769 to \$796.

Model 700 VS SF II (Varmint Synthetic, Stainless Fluted) – New for 2005, this varmint synthetic, heavy barreled version of the Model 700 has received upgraded features in response to our customers' requests. The reconfigured H.S. Precision composite stock has a contoured beavertail fore-end with defined ambidextrous finger grooves, palm swell and twin front tactical-style swivel studs to accommodate sling and bipod. The stock has a tactical green/black webbed textured finish. The 26-inch heavy contour, stainless barrel has a concave, target-style crown and six longitudinal flutes for rigidity, increased heat dissipation and weight reduction.
