We acknowledge with thanks receipt of the report above-identified, and note your reference to the Sweany fire control mechanism now used in Model 37.

We have pending two applications for patents on the Sweany fire control devices, including five different forms not less than three of which embody the feature of a connector between trigger and sear so arranged as to be moved by the sear when the sear is released, without requiring movement of the trigger. The Sweany applications have been pending in the Patent Office for about three years, have received several actions, and we are having substantial difficulty securing the allowance of any claims to this feature.

We do not think it would be possible to secure additional claims to the construction shown in Inventions Report No. IT-24 - such construction can be used without patent infringement.
