3. As to uses for their shotguns -

- the responding sportsmen report as fellows:

4. As with rifles, the pistel grip is favored -

- by about 8 to 1..

The findings:

Pistol grip 89.10% Straight 10.90%

This finding holds true of responding sportsmen of all age groups and shooters' ratings, and in approximately the same ratio.

5. The respondents as a whole are, apparently, only fairly well satisfied with present fore-end designs -

- with "gun nuts" and regular shooters less pleased with these designs than are occasional and infrequent shooters.
