2 In order to facilitate the procurement and reduce the cost of purchased components for the M/721-722, approval of the Products Committee is requested to cover the furnishing of the Trigger Plates for this rifle in aluminum alloy as an alternate for steel. This material will be similar in its characteristics as that now used for Butt Plates for Center Fire Rifles. It is understood that the vendor proposes to make a trial run with the new material in order to accurately determine the reduction in cost.

1 This action appears to be necessary in order that the Plant be assured of an adequate supply to take care of scheduled requirements on this gun.
