SHROUDED HEAD BOLY - MODEL TEL RIPLE - STREETH TESTS

You will recall that shortly after the strength tests were completed, you exhibited to me samples of the verious guns used and destroyed in the test which involved proof eartridges chambered against bullets lodged in the berrel. At that time I indicated to you that such a demonstration would be quite helpful in securing the allowance of patent claims covering the shrouded back.

It now appears advisable to arrange an interview with the Patent Examiner some time during the early per t of Jamuery, and I should like to exhibit to him actual samples of the guns tested. It is my resolication that in these tests you fired the 1905 Springfield, the Winshester Medel 70, and verious other rifles as well as the Model 721. Can you now assemble exhibits of the Springfield, Model 70, and 721 actions tested, having attached to each a tag identifying the lead cousing the failure, together with a tabulation of all guns tested, the locks asseing ultimate failure, and the nature of the failure? If such an exhibit could be shipped to me in a case of suitable weight for transportation to washington as personal beggage, it would be most halpful. Preferably, the case lid should be hinged and provided with a hasp or other closing device which would not require a hazmer and crowber for unpacking.

Should any question wise in connection with preparing this exhibit, I would suggest that you telephone we to save time.
