SUBJECT: MODEL 721 - 300 MAGNUM RIFLE

In accordance with decision reached at the Design Meeting held on January 20, 1949, will you kindly have a project prepared to provide a Model 721 - 300 Magnum in a heavier weight as submitted. According to Methods & Standards estimate supplied by T. W. Van Horne, the additional Factory Cost is \$2.47 per gun. Additional tooling cost has been estimated at \$4,400. G. E. Pinckney has requested that the economics be figured on the basis of increasing the retail selling price for this caliber by \$15.00 each, without any change in forecasted quantities.

The model gun which is being held in the Technical Department is to be forwarded to Bridgeport for Management approval when the project is submitted. Kindly advise us when this is to be done so we can forward the gun to the proper person.
