Ten of the above rifles were withdrawn from warehouse on 2/25/58 and subjected to test. Each rifle was fired 320 rds. using five types of assumition ranging from the 100 gr. builet on up to the 150 gr. builet.

Conclusions

- 1. All guns unload live ammunition satisfactorily.
- 2. Bight of the ten rifles close up hard on Minchester assumition. This is caused by a sharp ejector and soft breas.
- 3. Function-wise there was one bad performing gum having 10 failures to eject in 320 rds., for a rate of 36. The ejector on this rifle binds due to excessive brass shavings.
- 4. The trigger pull on rifle #701101 was way out of adjustment, and was corrected.
- 5. The extractor staking on gun #701333 came loose and resulted in the extractor turning over on the ejector, blocking it.
- 6. Inasmuch as there was no change in the inherent escuracy design of this caliber compared to the 30-06 caliber, accuracy test was deleted.
