### RULES FOR RECORDING EXPERIMENTS

1. Original records are to be in ink.
2. Each notebook page wherein there is recorded a completed experiment should be signed and dated by the experimenter in the space provided.
3. Each notebook page containing a completed experiment should be read and signed by a witness who will place his signature and the date in the space provided. The witness is to be one who understands the purpose of the experiment and the result obtained but who is not likely to be the inventor or a co-inventor. The witness should sign on the same day as the experimenter, or, if this is impracticable, as soon thereafter as feasible.
4. Where entries on a single experiment do not completely fill a page, the remainder of the blank page should be ruled out. Where the record of the experiment extends over several pages which are not consecutive, proper cross-references should be inserted.
5. The bound notebook is to be preserved intact. In no case should any page or part of a page be removed.
6. No erasures are to occur in the record. Any corrections or changes should be made by cancellation, leaving the original entry legible.
7. The same rules as to signing, dating and witnessing are to be followed when the original data are recorded on loose sheets or forms other than the standard bound notebook.

DURING NOVEMBER, 1960, IT WAS DECIDED TO  
BUILD A SINGLE SHOT PISTOL AND ACTION SIMILAR  
TO THE PISTOL OF 722. THIS GUN WAS TO HAVE A  
INTERCHANGEABLE BARREL STYLE GRIP (BOTH HANDS), FIVE  
LUMBER FEET LONG, AND 12 INCH BARREL.

THE FIRST MODEL WAS COMPLETED 12-1  
THE MIDDLE OF JANUARY 1961. THIS MODEL WAS  
IN PISTOL CALIBER. PRELIMINARY FIELD  
SHOWED THAT THE GUN COULD BE FIRED  
ACCURATELY FROM 5 FT TO 10 FT DISTANCE.  
SUBSEQUENT CHANGES IN SIGHT SETTING.

FOLLOWING THE COMPLETION OF THE FIRST  
MODEL A SWIVELING GRIP WAS MADE. THIS ALSO  
BEING 14 .22 CALIBER CARABINE. THIS GUN HAD  
A UNUSUAL PISTOL STYLE GRIP (LEFT OR RIGHT  
HAND) AND A 15 INCH BARREL. THESE INCHES  
WAS CUT OFF THE REARWARD LENGTH, THUS  
MAKING THE OVERALL LENGTH OF THE GUN 17 INCHES.  
TEST FIRING OF THIS GUN INDICATED THAT  
ACCURATE FIRING COULD BE DONE FROM SWIFT  
TO SWIFT WITHOUT CATCHING IN SIGHT SETTING.

THE PRELIMINARY RESULTS FROM TESTS ON THE  
FIRST TWO MODELS INDICATED THAT IT WOULD BE  
PREFERABLE TO DESIGN A SEMI-AUTOMATIC PISTOL TO  
ACCOMMODATE THE .22 CALIBER CARRIAGE. A MECHANICAL  
MODEL WAS MADE ON THE BASIS OF THE  
PREVIOUS, THIS MODEL FINALLY COMPLETED ON JANUARY  
13, 1961.

THE MECHANICAL MODEL AND THE SEMI-AUTOMATIC  
MODEL WERE PRESENTED TO MR. AND MRS. REMINGTON  
ON NOVEMBER 16, 1961 FOR APPROVAL. BOTH GUNS WERE  
REMOVED FROM THE PISTOL AND PLACED ON THE REMINGTON  
COUNSELOR ON NOVEMBER 13, 1961.






