I have never observed the stock warpage problem in the XP100. This investigation will take some time as I want to make a thorough analysis of the problem. Schedules, vacations, etc. will delay an answer until January, 1970.

X There are several micrometer peep sights available and can be readily attached to the XP100. I will test these also, and forward my recommendation.

Dr. Charles S. Cummings' book entitled, EVERYDAY BALLISTICS is an excellent source of information on calculating and understanding external ballistics. Enclosed are some excerpts of his book for your evaluation.
