MODEL 700 LEFT HAND - CALIBERS

At the Operations Committee we did not settle on the caliber designation since this question came up while you were out on field test, but it was left that a determination satisfactory to Ilion and Marketing would be made and reported back later. Since this rifle has been released to Production they are anxious for us to let them have the drawings, many of which will be affected by caliber designation.

This came up when Ilion discovered that the combination caliber and listing would mean some 9 different inventory items be carried for the spread of the forecasted 5,000 rifles per year. Walker is interested in this and I told him it should be of greater interest to Production who have to be taking care of such an inventory, and if there was any "negotiation" it might be more logically between you and A.D. Kerr.

At any rate, we would like to have an answer in order to be able to release the drawings, and information on this can be given to us in advance verbally.
