MOHAWK 600 - XP-100 BOLT PLUGS

Research has changed the design on the XP-100 Bolt Plug add-using the Mohawk 600 Plug. There is a substantial quantity of the present XP-100 Bolt Plugs on the plant which would take approximately five years to utilize on the XP-100. We propose to use these Bolt plugs up on the Mohawk 600 and XP-100 this year making a clean change to the new Bolt Plug on both items.

There is no functional problem using the XP-100 Bolt Plug on the Mohawk 600 as this Plug was utilized on this rifle for a number of years. The only problem is with the Mohawk 600 rifles to be exported to Australia. They must have the long Bolt Plug.

This recommendation is being made to utilize the XP-100 Bolt Plugs on the plant.
