MODEL 700 ADL & BDL RESTYLE

We have been asked by Marketing to look at certain changes to these models for 1982 introduction. We would appreciate information on the earliest dates the following items can be implemented.

Model 700 ADL

- Cut checkering (pattern similar to Model 725)
- Add Model 700 BDL floor plate to Model 700 ADL
- Add Model 700 BDL grip cap to Model 700 ADL
- Add sling swivel studs to this model
- Scope mounts
 - a. Remington design (per correspondence of 3-9-81 from Doug Bullis)
 - b. Purchase
 - 1) Buehler 2-piece bases and double split mount rings
 - 2) Redfield 5R 2-piece bases and one inch JR rings

We have contacted Purchasing to see if these companies can furnish parts in 25,000 - 50,000 and 100,000 quantities in time to begin fall warehousing.

- c. Design new mount that could be phased in at later date.
