SUBJECT: MODEL 700 ADL RESTYLE FOR 1983

Based on results of our discussion with Marketing and PE&C personnel on Monday, April 19, 1982, features planned for the restyled M/700 ADL to permit warehousing by December 1982 are as follows:

- Walnut stock - No fore-end tip
- Cut Checkering - 18 lines/inch
- Grip and fore-end (side panels only)
- Stock slimmer in grip area, but with same shape on grip end as current ADL
- No grip cap
- No white line spacers
- No rubber butt pad
- Sling swivel studs
- Medium gloss wood finish
- Improved metal finish
- ~~Clean barrel~~ *Iron sights - same as present M/700 ADL*

- ~~Seepe mounts - Machined aluminum~~
- Stamped "no bind" follower
- No floor plate
- Calibers; ^{.222, 6mm, 25-06} 22-250, ^{.243} .243, ^{.270} .270, 30-06, 7mm Mag. ^{.308}
