SUBJECT: IMPROVED METAL FINISH FOR M/700

RESTYLE AND MODEL SEVEN LIGHTWEIGHT

Based on experimentation on existing equipment at Remington and also at vendor's facilities, we will need to hand polish, vibratory and spindle finish the Bolt Handle - Bolt Assembly. Present capacity on polishing and vibratory equipment allows us to add use for M/700 ADL Restyle and the Model Seven Lightweight.

We will, however, need to purchase and install two new spindle finish tubs. Purchasing was given machine specification on 5/5/82 with a note saying that we need to have the tubs purchased, installed and running production by 7/15/82. Based on verbal quotes on deliveries we must place the order for these tubs by 5/31/82.

A contingency plan has been developed to run Bolt Handles - Bolt Assemblies and Bolt Plugs on the present ultramatic spindle finish equipment Bldg. 48-3 southwest. This will take care of Trial and Pilot and first two production months if necessary.
