Objective: To provide a new extractor that is easily installed, is more reliable and appears stronger than the current rivetless extractor.

Goals: o Extractor force against shell must not decline over a reasonable endurance life of the rifle.  
o Extractor must not interfere with bolt closing.  
o Extraction related malfunction rate less than M/700.

Stake: o Improved performance  
o Improved customer acceptance

Status: Two extractor designs are in the Model Shop to be fabricated.

Program o Fabrication complete  
Timing: o Developmental testing  
o Decide which extractor to continue  
o Redesign  
o Design acceptance test  
o Check CY drawings
