Please build the following two rifles for me. They will be used for the second focus panel review.

Let's talk about the details of building these guns. I think the barrelled actions that you have for the scope mount testing can be ~~add~~-used here.

Rifle One

- rounded receiver (slab sided, integral mounts)
- BDL barrel
- all satin receiver (except top rails)
- 700 • satin barrel, bolt plug, bolt handle, trigger guard and box
- black oxide follower - MURPHY
- 100 • satin black oxide bolt body (BDL stock)
- satin scope mounts - MURPHY
- low glass stock
- black english butt pad (M/R) .500?
- fore-end tip
- new grip cap - M/1400 GRIP CAP W/RA LOGO
- black line spacers - RAD POLNEY 8/19/85
- monte carlo, with cheekpiece

Rifle Two

- rounded receiver (slab sided, integral mounts)
- BDL barrel
- all standard polish metalwork

- plated follower
- ✓ • jeweled bolt body
- polished scope mounts - ^{CLASSIC STOCK} magazine
- ? • high glass stock
- ✓ • brown english butt pad
- ✓ • no fore-end tip
- ✓ • no grip cap
- ✓ • straight stock, no cheekpiece

Both stocks will be walnut with new checkering patterns. The magazine box and trigger guard are on order so don't worry about them yet. I will supply the scope mounts also.

Lets shoot for the middle of October for completion.
