SUBJECT: MONTHLY REPORT - AUGUST 1993

Roughly 30% of the month was spent learning our present systems for purchase parts inspection, receiving and storage (Crib 31) to better understand what improvements are needed and be able to fill in for L.B. Ferreira in his absence. Many of the technical routine tasks such as reviewing PPI process records I have taken over.

Hitchner (Investment Caster) was visited in an effort to bring them on-line with parts pulled from Vestshell. A 'Supplier Quality System Audit' was given to both of Hitchner's plants, Littleton and Nashau, NH. Both plants appeared very qualified. (8/10, 11, 12, 1993)

Goodyear Plant Quebec City, Canada, was visited to evaluate Remington's tooling for manufacture of recoil pads and review present and past technology. One tool was found to be deficient. We are awaiting quotes from the vendor before deciding on a course of action. (8/16, 17 & 18, 1993)

Bishop Gun Stocks was visited on 8/26 & 8/27 to review gaging of inletting on Model XP100 wood stocks to clarify problems vendor was having. Also, we adjusted shipping method of stocks to use Remington stock boxes to alleviate shipping damage.

Conducted make up safety meeting for PPI Tech. and receiving person for July. Conducted department August Safety Meeting.

Ron George, L.B. Ferreria and myself have initiated a regular meeting to make improvements on our current quality methods and systems.

A procedure to pre-qualify vendor materials is being set up.
