Safety, Health and Housekeeping:

Our noise reduction efforts in the test lab shooting room are essentially completed. All tubes have now been fitted with baffles and this along with the sound proofing materials have significantly reduced the level of noise in the area. One sprinkler head needs to be relocated and sound-proofing baffles need to be hung from the grid work and that will complete the work scheduled to date. We will schedule sound level measurements as soon as these last items are completed.

Maintenance:

The cost estimates and the write-up for the proposed changes to the shooting booth air handling system have been turned over to Dan Shumway for project economics and project submittal.

Test Programs:

Work continues on the Peerless. Various field function testing, high speed videos for the purpose of evaluating ejection and miscellaneous testing.

Testing continues on the Detachable Magazine Box project involving endurance testing, dry cycle testing and function testing.

A test is underway to determine if the heavy trigger pull on the Viper can be reduced.

The first of the new cantilever shotguns are being shot for accuracy, these guns will be going to the writer's seminar if acceptable.
