He said that they had a meeting last night to inform all of the instructors to encourage their hunters with model 700s with the bolt lock to send it in for inspection because they had a gentleman in the state who had a negligent discharge of one of these guns and supposedly "nearly blew his arm off" by shooting it very recently. How he nearly shot his own arm off I don't know, and didn't get into it.

Please remember that if you have someone claiming personal or property damage forward the call to Christy Mitchell as soon as possible. If we happen to get any calls about this gentleman, if it did in fact occur, don't get into it.

Also there IS NOT A RECALL ON THE MODEL 700, there is a Safety Modification Program in effect to remove the bolt lock on the safety and allow the older guns to be unloaded without putting the safety on the "fire" position.
