Based on information obtained from Steve Perniciaro and John Balio:

The X-Mark Pro fire controls are being phased into production.

There is no cut off date where Remington changed to this fire control from its standard fire control.

This is an add use change over. We will continue to use the standard fire control until we have exhausted the inventory and the new system is on all variations of the Model 700 and Model 7 firearms.

We started building rifles in production with the first X-Mark Pro fire controls in November of 2006. The first rifles were the stainless variety. December of 2006, was about a 50/50 split. January 2007 was about an 80/20 split. We will continue to build a limited number of M/700 SPS and SPS stainless into the 2nd quarter of 2007.

Carbon M/7's and M/700 LH rifles have not had the X-Mark Pro fire controls installed yet, the current plan is to begin these sometime after mid-year 2007.

To determine if the rifle has the standard fire control or the X-Mark Pro fire control it would be necessary to examine the rifle.
