# RIM FIRE RIFLES

Discontinuance of the Model 513-S has been approved by Management. At the request of the Plant, the committee approved the following decision:

The Operations Committee (Arms Division) recommends to Management that the Ilion Plant be authorized to provide a tenyear supply of spare barrels, receivers, and stocks for the Model 513-S, and a 15-year supply of other parts, and that they be authorized to dispose of any items of equipment or tooling for Model 513-S, and a 15-year supply be authorized to dispose of any items of equipment or tooling the Model 513-S when the necessary parts have been produced.
