

MODEL 740, 308 WINCHESTER

Pilot assembly of guns was made in May. Ten (10) guns were selected for pilot testing. At Arms Design's recommendation, a re-test was made using revised design Magazine Latches to improve the insertion of the box into the gun.

Fire Controls with new latches are being used for gun assembly. Assembly has started. A smooth action is required for the proper functioning of this gun. This is due to the lower pressure of the 308 caliber.
