Cleaning

Sales are issuing bulletins to the field force and to gunsmiths, stressing the importance of cleaning. They have also prepared new fold-over type tags for the Sportsman-58 and the center fire rifles, Models 721, 722, 740, and 760, to call attention to the importance of cleaning, and to provide a mail-in coupon to encourage the gun owner to obtain complete instruction folders if he did not receive them from his dealer.
