The committee questioned whether Management would agree to the introduction of the Model 725 with a substitute butt plate even for a short period of time. The Ilion Plant will proceed, therefore, on the assumption that it will be necessary to have the approved butt plate, and will give this problem special attention to prevent a delay in introduction. With this qualification, the Ilion Plant submitted the following warehouse schedule for the Model 725 in 30/06 caliber:

The Plant pointed out that this schedule refers anly to the 80/06 and that other calibers will follow.

The receiver and barrel marking submitted by Research and Development have been approved by Sales and the Patent Attorney, with the exception that the legend on the patent line referring to other patents which are pending should be deleted. This can be accomplished easily on existing rolls, but will leave the marker unbalanced.

To replace present rolls will cost approximately \$400, and the Ilion Plant asked whether it would be satisfactory to avoid this cost by using the present rolls until they are worn out, and centering the patent legend when new rolls are procured.
