MODEL 870

28 and 410 Gauges

The economic study submitted by N. F. Larsen had been reviewed by the members before the meeting. Sales Department stated that although a survey of the field force indicated a preference for adding the 28 and 410 gauges in the Model 870 and although this preference is reflected in the forecasts prepared by Sales as the basis for the economic study, the results of this study will not support any recommendation but the adoption of Plan 3. This calls for the deletion of the 28 and 410 gauge in the Model 11-48 and introduction in the Sportsman-58.
