

Arms Minute No. 11, 1957

In view of the potentially serious competitive situation, and the favorable economics of the overall program, the Committee took the following action:

Decision:

The Operations Committee, Arms Division, recommends to the Management introduction of the Model 722 222 Remington Magnum at the same prices as the same Model 722 222 Remington.

The combined economic summary for Arms and Ammunition will be presented with the recommendation to Management.

MODEL 740

Ejection Port Cover

Tests by Research and Development of the ejection port cover similar to that used on the Model 760 have been satisfactory and the Plant is proceeding with plans to start using this type of cover on the Model 740 in the latter part of December 1957.

It has been estimated by the Ticon Plant that this change will involve a vendor tool cost of \$2700 and will release for other use machine tools valued at \$5400. Factory cost should be reduced by approximately \$3,000 per year based on present forecasts.

Decision:

The Operations Committee, Arms Division, recommends to the Management, the introduction without obsolescence of a nylon ejection port cover on the Model 740.

ADL Fore-End Cap

The samples of nylon fore-end cap for the Model 740 submitted by Research and Development were returned by Sales with suggestions for modification. New samples have now been prepared and submitted by Research and Development to the Sales Department for evaluation.
