SICHTS

The Sales Department feels that we have not made design improvements in sights for our rifles (with particular reference to rim fire) comparable to the improvements made in other features. They therefore requested Research and Development to study this matter and determine what improvements could be made.

Research and Development submitted a preliminary report. All of the designs considered to date have indicated direct costs much higher than those of the present Model 510A sights.
