Since the meeting scheduled for July 1 will not be held, the information submitted by Research and Development and the Ilion Plant is summarized below for the benefit of the members.

SHOTGUNS

SPORTSMAN-58, A GRADE

Research and Development understands that the XS-3 (870 Auto-loader) would be acceptable to the Sales Department providing performance is as good as, or better than, the inherent functioning of the Sportsman-58 ADL as evidenced by the pilot and pre-pilot formal tests. This approval refers specifically to the magazine follower type of action release and to the absence of the Dial-A-Matic cap. The Sales Department should confirm this understanding as soon as possible.

MODEL 11-48, 28 and 410 Gauge

The Ilion Plant finds that if the small gauges in the 11-48 are to be discontinued at the end of 1959, it will be most economical for them to process the required parts to cover the remainder of 1958 and 1959. They will proceed on the assumption that this will be acceptable if they are not advised to the contrary.
