STUNNERS

MODEL 412 ONE-HAND STUNNER

As reported in Ilion Division Minute No. 1-59, design of the Model 412 One-Hand Stunner has been modified to include a new hard fiber hand grip and bolt actuating collar. The Committee has approved these design changes in principle, pending submission of economics for approval; a small cost reduction is indicated.

The Plant reports that model drawings of the improved Model 412 Stunner have been released for processing. No increase in tool cost will result from addition of the hard fiber hand grip and bolt actuating collar. The Plant further reports that hard fiber parts may be expected from the vendor in two months. Other tool parts necessary for assembly of 20 tools are on hand and, provided that vendor parts are received as expected, pilot tools can be assembled in June 1959 to permit announcement by the Sales Department in July.

The Model 412 One-Hand Stunner has been approved by Management (Informative Bulletin No. 15, Powder-Actuated Tool Division, dated December 3, 1958). In view of the determination that addition of proposed improvements will not increase tool cost, the Committee decided as follows -

Decision

The Operations Committee, Ilion Division, approves the appearance and design of the Model 412 One-Hand Stunner with present improvement modifications on the basis that improvement modifications will not detrimentally affect economics previously approved by Management.
