MODEL 411C Stunner

The Plant reports that there are no Model 411C Stunners in the warehouse at this time. Assembly completion has been delayed by a shortage of piston rods for this tool. Piston rods have been reordered, and are expected in stock by July 15.

The Sales Department reported that this item will be announced by a letter and folder covering the entire stunner line.

INDUSTRIAL GUN

MODEL 401 "KILMASTER"

The Plant reports that a Sight Bar has been added to Model 401 Breech Cover, as recommended by the Sales Department. Production started to incorporate the Sight Bar at the end of June. All Industrial Guns shipped after July 1 will have this feature.

The Sales Department stated their conviction that an entirely new Industrial Gun design is required if we are to meet competition in this field. It is the intention of the Sales Department to submit criteria for a new gun to the Committee as soon as it is developed from review of customers' opinions of desired gun features.

The Research & Development is in agreement with the concept of an entirely new Industrial Gun. The present Industrial Gun, while not considered unsafe with present loads, is considered to be structurally unsatisfactory for long life when used with Magnum shells.

The Committee generally discussed probable costs of an entirely new Industrial Gun, but reserved review until design criteria are available.
