SHOTGUNS

ARMS DEVELOPMENT SCHEDULE - SHOTGUNS

The Production and Research & Development Departments pointed out the necessity of early determination of the 1961 product line. The Committee will closely follow product requirements to insure that lead-time is given for adequate test and preparation of 1961 model additions.

The retention of Model 48 shotguns in 1961 was discussed. The Sales Department feels that this model must be continued until the XS-6, 5-shot autoloader is available to replace it.

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
