\*(Subsequent to the Meeting, on November 11; the Committee reconsidered the January, 1952 announcement date proposed for the 5-Shot Model 58. This announcement date is acceptable to the Sales Department and is agreed to by the Committee, provided that Sales Department field tests are completed prior to announcement or warehousing of this item, with ample time allowed for final corrections and modifications, before the item is shipped to customers).

The Sales Department further points out that the above schedule calls for retaining during 1962 the current Sportsman 58 in the line in all gauges, and the Model 11-48 in all gauges except 12. This will provide an all-gauge line of autoloaders during the introductory year of the 5-Shot Model 58.

On the basis of the above schedule, the Sales Department forecasts the 5-Shot Model 58 and the current Sportsman 58 as follows for the first full calendar year:
