

MODEL 760 - SLIDE ACTION RIFLE - CALIBER 223 (5.56mm) REMINGTON

Production reported rifles are being assembled for warehousing. However, they were unable to present accuracy data to the Committee to approve the new caliber for invoiced shipment due to pierced primers. A new lot of ammunition is expected the week of April 6. The Plant will forward data on product adequacy to the secretary as soon as it is available, to obtain Committee and General Management's approval for invoiced shipment before the May meeting.

GENERALWood Finishing

The electrostatic spray installation has satisfactorily finished the Model 1100 and 700 with RK-W. Production of lacquered stocks is scheduled the week of April 6 and full use of the unit for all stocks is scheduled by mid April. The obsolete Gyromat equipment will be dismantled in about a month.

These new facilities will reduce the cost of applying the RK-W finish. However, the cost of level sanding by hand before the final coat will not be affected by this installation.

1965 FIREARMS LINEModel 600 Carbine - Caliber 35 Remington Magnum

Research displayed a prototype carbine for Committee approval for release to Production. It features a laminated walnut and beech stock, recoil pad, RK-W finish, and 3/4 inch sling and swivels. It would retail for \$145, producing an estimated \$20,000 increased cash earnings, 50% return on total capital required (working capital only) and have a 17% profit margin. It would fit into the price structure of the Models 600 and 700 as follows:
