

1965 FIREARMS LINEModel 600 Carbine - Caliber 35 Remington Magnum

Research reported strength tests of the stock have proven adequate. They presented a prototype for approval to release to Production. The prototype as previously agreed has a laminated beech and walnut stock. Sales, however, wishes to reconsider marketing an all walnut laminated stock before settling on the walnut and beech stock.

Committee Action

The Committee approved and recommends General Management approve releasing to Production the caliber 35 Remington Magnum, subject to Sales and Management's future decision on marketing the laminated walnut and/or walnut and beech stock.

Model 870 - New Custom Checkering Pattern and RK-W Finish

Sales and Production presented a hand checkered prototype to the Committee to approve for release to Production.

Committee Action

The Committee approved and recommends General Management approve the new Custom Checkered pattern and RK-W finish on the Model 870.

Model 700 - Custom

Sales stated seven orders have been received for the Model 700 Custom. Some reaction has been received that insufficient value is being offered for the price.

Research discussed the myrtle-stocked version of the Model 700 Custom which could be offered to break even on the added scrap cost of the myrtle stock at \$50 additional net selling. The Committee concluded that reaction from the marketing of the French walnut-stocked rifle should be determined before deciding on a course of action for the myrtle-stocked rifle.
