

FIREARMSSHOTGUNSMODEL 1100 AUTOLOADING SHOTGUN28 and 410 Gauge

R & D suggested that a joint effort of Simmons and Remington be investigated for the production of 28 and 410 gauge Model 1100 conversions. Such a program should improve performance of the Simmons 28 gauge conversion. Also, it is believed that a 410 gauge conversion might be developed.

Since sales would be primarily to skeet shooters, the anticipated total volume is relatively low. Perhaps a similar offering by Simmons and Remington could be worked out. Remington might furnish part of the components and Simmons would make the conversions. Such a program might have a mutual advantage.

Marketing desires to make initial contact with Simmons to determine if such a program would be acceptable.

Committee Action

The Committee approved the suggested investigating of the proposed joint program. The objective is to develop and market a satisfactory conversion of the Model 1100 to handle the 28 and 410 gauge.

MODEL 32 OVER AND UNDER SHOTGUN

The offer to manufacture the Model 32 Over and Under Shotgun has been withdrawn by Taiwan (Republic of China). The possibility of procurement from other foreign country gun manufacturers was discussed.
