

SHOTGUNS - contd.OVER AND UNDER SHOTGUN - contd.

A letter dated May 25, 1965 (Table 1) was received from Mitsui & Co., Ltd., Chicago Branch (Importers and Exporters). Remington was requested to consider the nationwide distribution of Japanese shotguns.

The discussion brought out that while there may be problems of quality in procurement from a foreign manufacturer, Remington is still interested in the marketing of shotguns to fill out the line and particularly an over and under version. It is believed that DuPont has dealings with Mitsui & Co., Ltd. and as such, a control of quality might be handled through a DuPont representative located in Japan.

Committee Action

Marketing is to investigate the extent of DuPont tie-in with Mitsui & Co., Ltd. Also, Marketing is to make further investigations including obtaining sample shotguns for evaluation.

CBC - SINGLE BARREL SHOTGUNS

The marketing in the United States and Canada of single Barrel, 12 gauge break-action shotguns manufactured by CBC has been proposed. Marketing presented a report (Table 2) of economics and competitive gun listings.

CBC has also requested Remington to consider handling export to any foreign country.

A cutaway sample 16 gauge shotgun has been reviewed by Marketing. The Receiver is chrome plated but for sale by Remington, the finish would be black.
