pointed out that the plastic Deflector for the Model 552 was not adequate and R & D is redesigning the part. Announcement of these rifles is now scheduled for January 1966.

Committee Action

The general appearance of the Model 552 and 572 "BDL" grade rifles was considered satisfactory. The Model 552 Deflector is to be redesigned by R & D.

MODEL 6600 AUTOLOADING RIM FIRE RIFLE

R & D reported that of the one hundred and one (101) part drawings, forty-seven (47) are add-use components. Of the fifty-four (54) new parts, twenty (20) had been transmitted to the plant. It is hoped that all drawings can be released by the end of June.

Production reported that processing and tool design is progressing on released components.

This new gun, in addition to the dressed-up models and added calibers, is needed for announcement January 1966.

Committee Action

R & D is to expedite release of drawings for processing.

The Ilion plant is to review the program to determine if warehousing of rifles not later than the end of March 1966 can be accomplished.

MODEL 580-581-582 RIM FIRE BOLT ACTION RIFLESMODEL 788 CENTER FIRE BOLT ACTION RIFLES

R & D reported that essentially all of the model drawings except for the Magazines had been transmitted and the Ilion plant released for processing and procurement.
