PELLET GUNS AND PISTOLS

Based on the preliminary study, production of pellet guns and pistols would not produce a satisfactory return. R & D has discontinued any program to develop a line of pellet guns or pistols based on any of the existing methods of powering. Should a design develop that warrants investigation in the future, the program can be reactivated.

Committee Action:

Present work will be limited to the development of pellets. Consideration of guns and pistols will be dropped by the Committee.

TELESCOPES AND MOUNTS

Visits were made by representatives of Marketing and R & D to eastern distributors. The consensus of opinion was that Remington should not enter the scope and mount field without a complete line and a product that would offer desirable features not now available in this field.

The reaction of western and mid-western distributors might indicate a more favorable picture. However, the opinion was that Remington should not enter the scope and mount field with the program that had been presented.

Consideration had been given to the acquisition of a major scope and houst manufacturer.
