Additional sample pads (red with black backer) were received from Firestone. The effect of Toluene on the Firestone pad is greater than with the Pachmayr. This problem remains to be resolved.

Pachmayr will not license Remington to use the white line spacer. The reasons given are that the "white line" is a trademark which identifies Pachmayr and second, there might be an adverse effect on the pending infringement lawsuits.

Committee Action:

The manufacturing problems should be promptly resolved. The Firestone pad is to be used on the selected guns. (Reference October Minutes #19)

CENTER FIRE RIFLESMODEL 742-760

Marketing recommended the addition of RK-W to Model 742 and 760 "A" grade rifles. The proposed pricing for 1967 would cover the added cost of \$1.57 each.

Since warehouse quantities are low, this changeover can be effected for 1967 announcement. Production will probably ship some rifles with the RK-W finish in December.

Committee Action:

The committee approved the RK-W finish for the Model 742 and 760 "A" grade to be effective January 1, 1967.

Management approved the changeover from lacquer to RK-W finish in 1964.
