

CENTER FIRE RIFLES - contd.MODEL 700 CENTER FIRE BOLT ACTION RIFLE  
MODEL 660 CENTER FIRE BOLT ACTION RIFLERifle with Mannlicher Stock

A prototype of the proposed Model 660 and the previously reviewed Model 700 with "ADL" grade features were shown to the Committee. The rifle would have sling straps and swivels.

Marketing would consider the introduction of the Model 660 regular and a Mannlicher Stock version for 1968 announcement. The Mannlicher Stock rifle would be in the 222 Remington, 6mm Remington, 243 Winchester and 308 Winchester calibers.

Factory costs and economics for the Model 660 rifle with Mannlicher Stock having the features of the prototype rifle are to be developed. Costs for the Model 700 "ADL" were presented at the September meeting (Minutes #17, Exhibit 2) and can be used for comparison.

The addition of a Model 700 rifle with Mannlicher Stock and "BDL" features would be considered at a later date. This would be dependent on customer demand for such a rifle.
